

Dear ICP Candidates and Applicants,

ICP offers a number of different financial support programs for Candidates in the Psychoanalytic Training Program. Each of these programs has distinguishing characteristics and conditions, but taken together, they offer the possibility of assistance for those in need of support in meeting the financial obligations of psychoanalytic training.

- First, there is a **general scholarship program** with monies drawn from the ICP Scholarship Fund. These scholarships are based solely on need, and are available only to candidates in the four-year and weekend psychoanalytic training programs. Applicants must submit the required Application for Financial Aid.
- Second, an **Ethnic Minority scholarship** is available through the ICP Taskforce to Address Racism and Homophobia, to promote diversity within the psychoanalytic community at ICP. Eligibility requirements are as follows:
  - A. Applicants may be participants in the Extension, Psychoanalytic Psychotherapy or Four-Year/Weekend Psychoanalytic Programs.
  - B. Applicants must be people of color.
  - C. Applicants must demonstrate financial need.
  - D. Applicants must submit the same Application for Financial Aid as those applying for the general scholarship program; however, duplicate forms of the Application must be submitted to the Scholarship and Loans Committee and the ICP Taskforce to Address Racism and Homophobia.
  - E. Applicants who are in full training to become psychoanalysts must agree to participate in a diversity workshop, sit on the Taskforce, or teach a class with a Taskforce member.

***(Recipients of all scholarship awards should note that scholarship funds are customarily applied directly as a credit against financial obligations (largely but not exclusively) for tuition payment.)***

- Third, candidates in the full ICP psychoanalytic training program may apply for **tuition deferral loans** which allow a spacing out of tuition payments rather than full up-front payment of tuition. Applicants must submit the required Application for Financial Aid. **Successful applicants are advised that partial repayment of loans begins at \$75 monthly, from October 1 in the calendar year of award.**

Please find attached the required Application for Financial Aid. You may use the same form to apply for any or all of the above types of financial aid. If you need an application sent to you for the above programs, please contact the ICP office. Completed applications must be received at the **ICP mailing address no later than August 24, 2018 at 12:00 pm PST.**
